



Internationalisation - Facts & Figures


- Out of 1,959 graduates 14.7 % are international. (2015/16)
- Out of 13,454 students 19.1% are international. (2016/17)
- Out of 1,944 beginners 25.4 % are international. (2016/17)



- Out of 1,959 graduates 16.6 % study abroad. (2015/16)
- Out of 3,411 employees 16.5 % come from abroad. (30.6.2017)



Internationalisation as Strategic Project Achievements



- Internationalisation of study programmes
 - Since 2013 all 14 doctoral programmes in English
 - By winter term 2017/18 14 master programmes in English
- New mobility programmes additionally for students (shorter programmes: e.g. joint lectures, summer schools)
- Education & Internationalisation Committee as advisory body for strategic development



Internationalisation as Strategic Project Achievements

- Establishment of a Welcome Center:
 - Partner for all international guests,
 faculty & staff, degree seeking students
 - Living in Austria (visa, accommodation, school, kindergarten, medical assistance, public transport, driver's licence, etc.)
 - Networking and integration: regular's table, picnics, day trips, workshops on special topics (e.g. taxes)
 - Intercultural awareness sessions
 - German courses
 - Welcome Days for international students





Internationalisation as Strategic Project Achievements

- Increase in student mobility
- New mobility programmes for faculty & staff
- Increase of faculty & staff mobility
- Training programmes & support measures for faculty & staff:
 - Language courses
 - Teaching in English
 - Intercultural awareness trainings
 - Proofreading service
 - Coaching (English)

Internationalisation as Strategic Project

- What more is to be accomplished?
 - Further increase of student, faculty & staff mobility
 - Increase of courses taught in English in German taught programmes (bachelor and master)
 - Orientation week for international students in English master programmes
 - Decentralising internationalisation (coordinators on faculty level, coordinators for cooperations & mobility)
 - Evaluation of English programmes
 - Marketing, to get additional good international students

- Opening of alumni chapter in Zurich
- Opening of ESA Business Incubation Center Austria
- CD Laboratory for Semantic 3D Computer Vision with US partner
- CD Laboratory for Design of high-performance alloys by thermomechanical processing with partners from Poland, Germany, Switzerland, France, Italy, Hungary, Japan
- Summer School in "Food Science and Culinary Arts to Maximize Food Quality" with students from the US, Switzerland, Belgium, Spain
