Dear colleague,

We cordially invite you to crp2021, the 39th Conference of Rectors and Presidents of European Universities of Technology.

The global nature of the challenges that our planet is facing demands new approaches of policy, industry, education and research, and the general public. The Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) the reports of the International Panel for Climate Change (IPCC), the Paris Agreement 2015 form the framework for action. The European New Deal defines Europe's commitment to tackling climate and environmental-related challenges as this generations defining task. Universities have a special role to play in that context. Borders between disciplinary silos need to be overcome and new structures and initiatives for interdisciplinary cooperation in education and research have to be considered including involving non-academic parties in transdisciplinary arrangements.

- identifying differences and commonalities of existing solutions to problems of common interest,
- developing new ideas and if appropriate preparing recommendations on specific topics, and
- forming a 'think tank' for the future development of the universities of technology in Europe.

As an informal grouping, the conference has no formal international or European organisational structure.

Discussions at the 2021 Conference will address issues such as:

- Reconsidering university structures examples of good practices in teaching and research
- Opportunities for high risk/high gain research Are universities prepared?
- TUs' roles in developing public awareness and understanding of global challenges
