


Unite!

- Outreach S&T culture to secondary schools





Italian and local context

The result is a clear responsibility to work to the benefit of the society at territorial and national level.








Priority Areas for Urban Development in Torino (Mirafiori, Valentino, C.so Marche,...)


Priority Areas and key strategic trajectories for PoliTo (Smart Mobility, Green Architecture, Areospace, ...)


PoliTo -> the main investor in urban regeneration in Torino (investment around 300 MEuro, construction phase from 2022 to 2026)

Biennale Tecnologia

- <u>Politecnico di Torino</u> presents, in synergy with local players, a biennial event dedicated to **technology's decisive impact on each aspect of human life** from health to environment, from interpersonal relationships to democracy
- Biennale Tecnologia offers to the citizens an articulated, inclusive and accessible reflection on the increasingly relevant issue of the relationship between technology and society
- The program includes lessons, debates, workshops and exhibits with international guests, with a strongly interdisciplinary approach, enriched by the languages of fiction, cinema, music and figurative arts. Laboratories and learning activities, some of which specifically designed for primary and secondary schools, are included.
- 1st edition in 2020, 2nd edition going to start soon





Looking for energy solutions: the possible role of nuclear

- No NPPs operate in Italy since the post Tchernobyl referendum (confirmed by the post Fukushima referendum)
- However, nuclear was included in 2022 in the green taxonomy and is being reconsidered also as a consequence of the current crisis
- Whereas PoliTo is strongly focused on renewable energy R&I, it is going to sign a partnership agreement with fission start-up newcleo (GenIV LFRs), and it is very active since 30+ years on the front of fusion (ITER, DTT, EU-DEMO, ...)
- Maybe nuclear could provide medium to long term contributions to the portfolio of sustainable solutions to the Italian energy dependence as well as a safeguard against future global energy crises ...
- ... and S&T Universities bring some rationality in the public debate on this topic
