Invitation to the 2023 Conference at TU Dublin

Dear colleague,

We cordially invite you to crp2023, the 41st Conference of Rectors and Presidents of European Universities of Technology, at Technological University Dublin in Ireland.

Digital transformation spans many concepts such as artificial intelligence, cloud computing, Internet of Things, and big data, and is inducing fundamental changes in all parts of society including universities. Universities of technology have particular tasks and should take leading roles in shaping these general developments. At the same time, they need to decide how to use the opportunities offered by digitalisation in the most appropriate ways for their activities in education and continuing education, research and innovation, and outreach as well as for many aspects of institutional management always choosing the right balance between digital and traditional analogue approaches. General background of the conference:

Following a joint initiative of the rectors of Vienna University of Technology and RWTH Aachen University, this conference started in 1980 with the aim of establishing an informal platform for top representatives of leading science and engineering universities in Europe for:

- Discussing topics of major common concern, that are not discussed in other fora,
- identifying differences and commonalities of existing solutions to problems of common interest,
- developing new ideas and if appropriate preparing recommendations on specific topics, and
- forming a 'think tank' for the future development of the universities of technology in Europe.

As an informal grouping, the conference has no formal international or European organisational structure.
